Anderson - Maurice C. "Bill" White, 81, Anderson, died September 11, 2002 at Community Hospital, Anderson after extended illness. He was born March 19, 1921 in Lapel, Indiana, and resided in Anderson, Indiana. He lived in this area all of his life. He retired from the US Army in 1972 after 30 years of service. He also retired in 1986 as a Finish Carpenter for Harley Campbell Construction for 14 years and was an upholsterer all around Central Indiana for 40 years. He was a 1940 graduate of Pendleton High School. He served in the 101st Airborne during WWII. He parachuted into Normandy on D Day and fought in the Battle of the Bulge. His military awards include Bronze Star Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster 2, the Purple Heart, Meritorius Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal, Good Conduct Medal, Master Parachutist Badge with Two Battle Stars and the Combat Infantry Badge. He attended South Anderson United Methodist Church in Anderson. He was a life member of the American Legion in Pendleton, Veterans of the Battle of the Bulge, 101st Airborne Division and Military Order of the Purple Heart.
