Max Edwin Markle, 91, of Markleville passed away Tuesday, March 5, 2019.

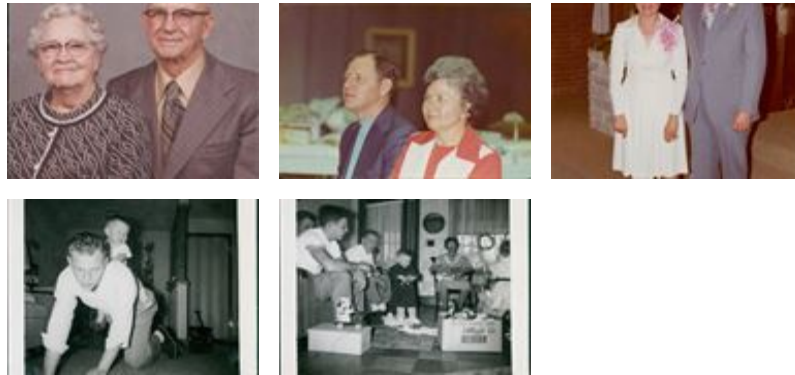
