March 3, 1920 - July 14, 2004

Houston, TX - Maxine Hert Hofer, 84, of Houston, died July 14, 2004 at Memorial Hermann Memorial City Hospital in Houston, Texas. She was born March 3, 1920 in Greene County, Indiana, the daughter of Herschel Charles Hert and Ruth Charity Brandon Hert.
