Anderson - Melvin E. "Bud" Biddle, 87, Anderson, passed away December 17, 2010 at St. Johns Health System, Anderson Indiana after a sudden illness. He was born November 28, 1923 in Daleville, Indiana, and resided in this area all of his life. Bud served his country in the US Army as a paratrooper at the Battle of the Bulge during WWII. He retired from The Veterans Administration. He was the last living recipient to receive the Congressional Medal of Honor in Indiana from World War II.
