Your influence on us all and Life lessons will live forever within our souls.

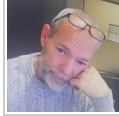

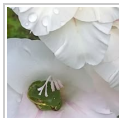

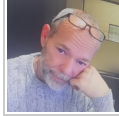
