Norman Humphries, 91, of Anderson, passed away on November 6, 2020, at Provenience of Anderson. He was born on June 19, 1929 in Alexandria, Indiana to Samuel F. and Gertrude Venita (Collins) Humphries, and he moved to Anderson in 1975.

Norman served his country in the United States Army and was stationed in Korea. He then served in the Army National Guard for 20 years.

He worked for the United States Postal Service, and retired after 28 years of service. After his retirement, Norman also had a number of part-time jobs around Madison County including managing apartments in Chesterfield and working at True Value.
