Before moving back to the United States, she contracted Polio which she suffered with the rest of her life. They were then stationed in Texas until Bob took inactive duty and moved back to Anderson. She then moved to Noblesville in 1990 and then to Fishers in 2002 where she has since lived. She was a homemaker and she was a longtime Shaklee Distributor. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Anderson. She was a 1947 graduate of Pendleton High School and attended Indiana University for two years. She was a member of the Zeta Alpha Tau Sorority and the local Sigma Phi Gamma Sorority. She and Bob were very active with a group of friends that all graduated around the same time and whom they have spent almost every New Years with, they refer to them as, "The Pendleton Gang". She also was a member of several bridge clubs including the South Edgewood Bridge Club and the Lake Stonebridge Bridge Club. She and her family was recognized as, "1987 Family Of The Year" by the Anderson Mental Health Center. She loved to travel, especially cruises and love to be with family and friends.
