Paul N. Trent, 70, of Chesterfield, went to be with his Heavenly Father May 10, 2017 at his residence. He was born on December 9, 1946 in Terre Haute, Indiana.

Paul graduated from Garfield High School in Terre Haute and was a Proud Purple Eagle. He graduated from Frankfort Pilgram College and Seminary at Anderson College.

He ministered at Parkview Wesleyan Church, Chesterfield since 1995. He previously served the Lebanon Wesleyan Church from 1978-1995, Calvary Wesleyan Church, Indianapolis from 1977-1978, Southview Wesleyan Church, Indianapolis from 1973-1977 and served as Youth Pastor at Forrest Hills Wesleyan Church in Evansville in 1973.
