January 26, 1939 - July 7, 2006

Paula Joan Stohler Nugent died on July 7 at St. Vincent Hospice after a brief illness. She was born January 26, 1939, to Paul and Audrey Ridgeway Stohler Gooding of Anderson, Indiana. She was a graduate of Markleville High School in 1956, completed Deaconess training in 1959 serving at St. John's in Baltimore, MD, and achieved her B.S. Degree from Ball State University in 1965. She taught at Liberty H.S. and was a Madison County 4-H Extension Agent. She also enjoyed teaching children at a preschool, as a substitute teacher, and Christian education at various Lutheran churches. On June 9, 1968, she married Rev. Dr. Daniel L. Nugent at Mt. Zion Lutheran Church. She was his faithful helpmate in the Indiana ELCA pastorates they served at Ovid, Winchester, Kokomo, Ft. Wayne, Brookville, Elwood, and Sunman. Most recently, she assisted her husband with his work as Chaplain at Wernle Children's Home. Paula was a wonderful wife, mother, grandmother, sister, aunt, friend and servant of God. She is survived by her husband, Rev. Dr. Daniel L. Nugent of Richmond, daughter Paula Steiner husband David of Alexandria, VA, son Daniel P. Nugent of Batesville, and grandson Aidan Steiner. She is also survived by sisters Delarose Gustin, Grace Markle husband Harold, Faith Burmeister husband Jim of Anderson, and brother David Stohler wife Judy of Bluffton.
