



Bishop R.B. Bingham Jr.

September 12, 1934 - August 31, 2020

Bishop R.B. Bingham, 85, of Anderson, passed away on August 31, 2020 at St. Vincent's Anderson Regional Hospital Anderson. He was born on September 12, 1934 in Milledgeville, Tennessee, and resided most of his life in Anderson.

Bishop Bingham graduated with a Master's Degree in Theology from Parkersburg Bible College.

He was the Bishop of The First Pentecostal Church in Anderson.

He was a member of The First Pentecostal Church since 1966, Charter Member of The Assemblies of the Lord Jesus Christ since 1952. He was preacher of the Gospel, and devoted his life to church work and missions. He was a certified scuba diver, and licensed pilot. He loved to go hunting and fishing. He lived for his family.

Bishop Bingham is survived by his loving wife, Mary Bingham; son, Michael Edward (Trish) Bingham; daughter, Judith Sue (Danny) St.Clair; grandchildren, Jody (Jeff) Brantley, Labanon (Tiffini) Bingham; Luke (TJ) St.Clair; brother, Maxell (Ann) Bingham; 10 great-grandchildren; several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Rev. R.B. Sr. and Frances Bingham.
