Anderson - Raymond Earl "Mac" McCaslin, 95, Anderson, passed away December 7, 2009 at St. Johns Health System, Anderson Indiana after a brief illness. He was born July 27, 1914 in New Haven, Connecticut, and resided in Anderson since 1975. Mac graduated from Washington High School in 1933 and Indiana University in 1940. He served his country in the US Navy during WWII. He retired in 1979 from Sears after 33 years of service.
