November 26, 1923 - July 12, 2006

Anderson - Rev. Russell A. Robold, 82, Anderson, left this world to enter into his heavenly rest on Wednesday, July 12, 2006 at St. Johns Health System, Anderson Indiana after a year and a half illness. He was born November 26, 1923 in Kankakee, Illinois, and resided in Anderson. Russell married Elizabeth Sue Staggs on August 10, 1944. He was ordained into the ministry by the Church of God, Anderson, Indiana in 1950. They pastored twelve congregations in Indiana, Oklahoma, Texas, Ohio and Tennessee. He retired from active pastoral ministry in October of 2005. He served his country in the US Army Air Corps during WWII as a member of the 92nd Bomb Group. He flew 30 missions over occupied Europe as a radio operator gunner 757 on B17 while stationed in Podington, England, earning the Distinguished Flying Cross and the Air Medal with 4 oak leaf clusters. He is survived by his wife, Elizabeth Sue Staggs Robold; a son, Rev. Claude Robold & wife Janice of Middletown, Ohio; four daughters, Melanie Lashbrook & husband Rev. Bill Lashbrook of Anderson, Deborah Fife of Lapel, Rebekah Wagster & husband Rev. Ron Wagster of Beaver Falls, Pennsylvania and Rev. Rene' McGuire & husband Rev. Kevin McGuire of Middletown, Ohio; four brothers, Orville & wife Marian of Minneapolis, Minnesota, Virgil of Anderson, Earl & wife Virginia of Tucson, Arizona and Forrest of West Virginia; eighteen grandchildren; and ten great grandchildren.
