Richard Alan Jones, Jr., 58, of Bensenville, IL, died unexpectedly at his home on December 1, 2017. He was born on October 18, 1959 in Muncie, and resided most of his life in Anderson.

Alan moved to Anderson, Indiana in 1966, graduating from Anderson High School in 1978. In 1983, he received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Industrial Management from Purdue University.

He was a member of Alpha Sigma Phi Fraternity. He worked for Claussen, a division of Oscar Meyer, for 4 years, and Kellogg for 3 years, then retiring.

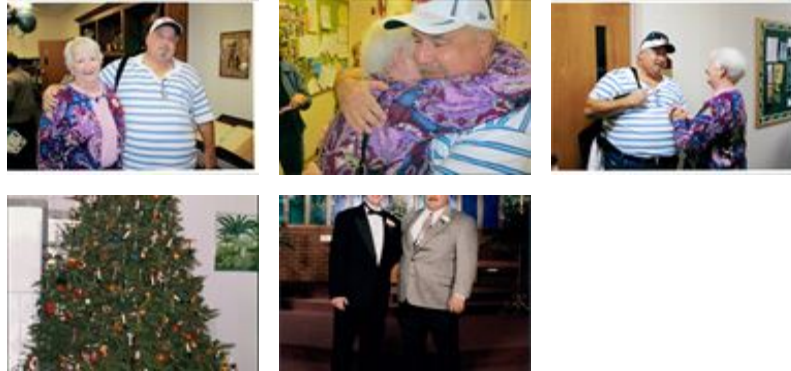

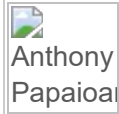

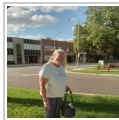
