Richard Lee May, 79, of Carmel, Indiana, entered into eternity with his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on Feb. 11, 2023. He was born Oct. 23, 1943, in Anderson, Indiana, where he resided most of his life.

Dick graduated from Anderson High School in 1961 and Indiana University, earning a bachelor's degree in 1965 and an MBA in 1967. In his lifelong work as a Certified Public Accountant, Dick lovingly and faithfully served hundreds of clients, including many on a pro-bono basis.

He was an active member of Christ Community Church in Carmel and served several organizations as a volunteer and board member, including the Chamber of Commerce in Madison County, Alternatives, the United Way, and the Warren Home. He enjoyed playing cards, especially bridge at the Monon Center, traveling with his wife, and watching his Indiana Hoosiers play basketball and Dodgers play baseball. He loved and was proud of his children and grandchildren.
