Rev. Robert E. James, 100, of Anderson, passed away on March 30, 2017 at the Good Shepherd Hospice House Sebring, FL. He was born on March 12, 1917 in Delaware, Ohio to Walter and Ruth Anna James.

Robert graduated from Olivet Nazarene College in 1949.

He was ordained in the Church of the Nazarene in 1951, and pastored for 37 years in several churches in Indiana.

He was a member of The New Life Church of the Nazarene, an active member of Christian Literature for Africa, and a retired elder in the Church of the Nazarene.

Rev. James is survived by his loving spouse whom he married on April 13, 1940, Imogene Lucille (Cole) James, children, Tom (Carol) James, Nancy (Don) Ault, Ruth (Frank) Brown, sister, Marjorie Ramey, eight grandchildren, 12 great-grandchildren, and two great-great-grandchildren.
