Robert "Bob" Breese Morse, 86, of Anderson, passed away peacefully on March 19, 2013 at Community Hospital. He was born on June 3, 1926 in New Castle, Indiana and resided most of his life in Anderson. Bob graduated from Anderson High School class of 1944 and earned a degree in Economics from Depauw University and an accounting degree from IU.
