Robert L. Zook, 89, of Anderson, went home to be with The Lord, and his wife, Mary, on November 7, 2013. He was born on August 18, 1924 in Greencastle, Indiana and resided most of his life in Anderson. Bob graduated from Muncie Central High School in 1942, and he served his country in the Army during WWII. He retired as an Engineer for Guide Lamp Division of General Motors with more than 33 years of service. He traveled extensively for General Motors, to Detroit, Mexico, Canada, and Australia, and his family often traveled with him. Bob loved to tinker in his garage, designing clever solutions to simple problems, leading to inventions like The Zook Quilting Frame.
