Ron Gibson, 62, of Anderson, passed away on January 3, 2023. He was born on August 4, 1960, in Chillicothe, OH, the son of Howard and Viola (Mattox) Gibson.

Ron was a 1979 graduate of Urbana High School in Urbana, OH. Following high school, he joined the U.S. Marine Corps. Upon leaving active duty, Ron graduated from Anderson University. He retired from the military after 26 years of service.

Ron was a teacher and coach at Alexandria-Monroe Middle School, Indianapolis Public Schools, and Daleville Elementary School. He was loved by all of his current and former players, students, and colleagues.
