



Ronald "Ronnie" Earl Jones

Ronald "Ronnie" Earl Jones, 84, Pendleton, passed away on January 12, 2023, at Sugar Fork Crossing after a brief illness.

He was born on June 25, 1938, in Louisville, KY and resided in Pendleton, IN all of his life. Ronnie was a member of the United Methodist Church in Pendleton.

He retired from Guide Lamp after 43 years of service. During his employment he worked as a die setter, AMA and participated in several projects that improved the productivity of the machinery where he was acknowledged and rewarded with compensation.

Ronnie was married to the love of his life, Barbara Kay (McLaughlin) Jones on April 24, 1959. To that union they had two children, Stephanie and Rodney. Ronnie was a huge supporter of Madison County 4-H for many years. 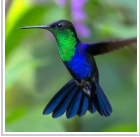
