Roy Harold Wolfskill, age 91, Anderson, IN, formerly of Temple, PA, passed away peacefully at Community Hospital in Anderson on October 16th, 2009. He was born on December 11, 1917 in Reading, PA, the son of George and Mary Boyer Wolfskill.

He was retired from Firestone Tire and Rubber Company and was a WW II Veteran where he served in the Medical Corp.

He was an active member in churches in the Boyertown District Church of God, Anderson, IN since the age of 16. He loved working with young people there.
