Sandra "Sandy" (Sandefur) Keesling, age 68, passed away on September 30, 2025, after a courageous battle with Alzheimer's Disease. She is now reunited in heaven with the love of her life, her husband Jim, who preceded her in death in 2018.

Sandy had a heart for helping others and a vibrant spirit. She loved live concerts, beach vacations, and most of all, spending time with her grandsons, who were the absolute joy of her life.

She is survived by her devoted daughter, Lindsey Keesling (Andrew Peters); her brother, Scott Sandefur (Maggie), niece Hayden Sandefur; and her beloved grandsons, Ellis (9) and Easton (6). She also leaves behind her treasured cat, Sugar Bell.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Jim Keesling; her parents, Jack Sandefur and Bonnie Triplett; her stepfather, Carl Triplett; her in-laws, Joe and Beverly Keesling; and her dear friend, Joanie Fowler.
