Cremation will take place.

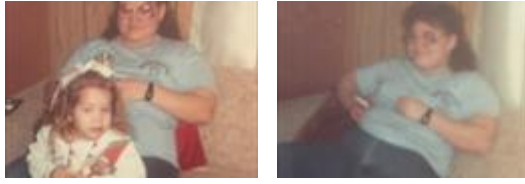
