Terry H. Farling, 64, of Anderson, passed away on September 30, 2014 at Ball Memorial Hospital. He was born on September 6, 1950 in Portland, Indiana and resided most of his life in Indiana.

Terry graduated from Muncie Central High School, and he served his country in the Army in Washington D.C. at the Pentagon during the Vietnam War. He also attended Ball State University, and Regent University.

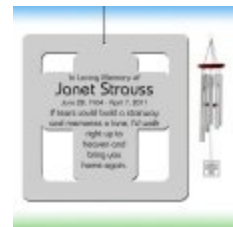

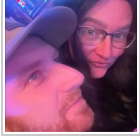
