Thomas Chezem, 80, of Pendleton, passed away on June 20, 2019. He was born on January 6, 1939 in Anderson, and resided most of his life in Pendleton.

Tom graduated from St. Mary High School of Anderson in 1956. He then earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Education from Purdue University in 1961, and went on to earn a Master's Degree from Ball State University.

He was a math teacher and coach at both St. Mary's High School in Anderson, and Madison Heights High School where he retired after 32 years of service in 1996.

He was a parishioner and usher of St. Ambrose Catholic Church in Anderson where he helped with Boy Scout Troop 301, was president of the Holy Name Society twice, and was a member of the Knights of Columbus Council #563. Tom was an avid outdoorsman where he would enjoy camping and fishing, but he especially loved spending time with his family.

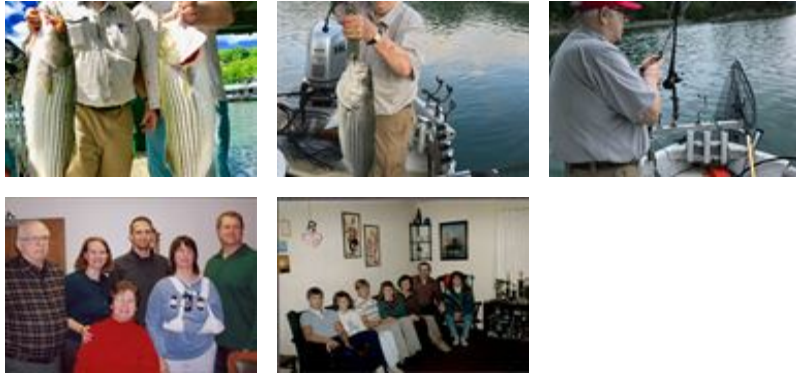
