Timothy "Tim" Lee Branch, 74, of Ingalls, passed away unexpectedly on December 11, 2022. He was born on August 8, 1948, in Anderson, Indiana to Joseph and Mary Alice (Richardson) Branch.

Tim graduated from Pendleton High School in 1966. He married the love of his life, Willa Mae Chapple in 1967, and was happily married for 55 years. He was very dedicated to her and their family until his untimely death.
