Virginia B Hays, 94, of Anderson, passed away on May 28, 2023, at the Sugar Fork Crossing Assisted Living in Anderson. She was born on October 26, 1928, in Anderson, Indiana, and resided most of her life in the Markleville, IN area before moving to back to Anderson. She graduated from Markleville High School in 1946 and she attended Earlham College for 1 year before marrying Horace Hays in 1948.

Virginia was a lifetime member of Epsilon Sigma Alpha Sorority, Charter member of Amvets Auxiliary #25 for 71 years, and National Amvets Auxiliary President from 2003-2004, during her time in office she represented Amvets at the National unveiling of the WWII monument dedication in Washington D.C. where she attended a dinner at the White House. She was also on the Board of the Madison County 4H Association, a member, and a Deaconess of East Christian Church Markleville. Virginia also participated in local golf and bowling leagues. She retired from GM in 1991.

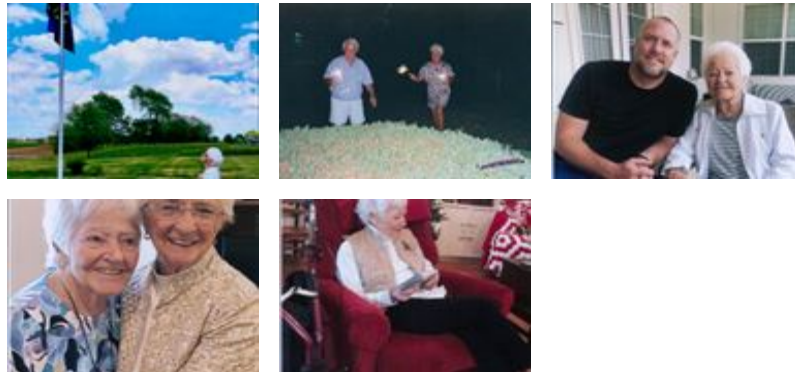
