



## Virginia C. Thomas-Adams

July 31, 1931 - January 5, 2025

Virginia C. Thomas- Adams, 93, died peacefully at her home on Sunday evening, January 5, 2024, at her residence in Alexandria, following an brief illness.

She was born on July 31, 1931, in Albany, Kentucky and resided most of her life in rural Alexandria.
