A wonderful man passed away in Salt Lake City, Utah on August 31st from causes related to age. William Bill P. Boman Sr. was born in Overton County Tennessee on February 12th, 1920 . He was the son of Benjamin and Bessie Padgett Boman. He served his country in the United States Army during WW II in the Pacific. After the War, he settled in Anderson, Indiana where he resided for 56 years. He was employed at Container Corp. for 37 years until his retirement in 1982.
