William Paul Duncan, 77, passed away on December 24 of a short illness. He was born in Anderson on July 13, 1938 and attended Anderson High School, where he was in the marching band and graduated in 1956. He served in the U.S. Marine Corps for three years, and then attended Purdue University, where he also was a member of the Purdue marching band, and graduated in 1964 with a B.S. in Electrical Engineering. Upon graduation, he accepted a position with General Motors at Delco Remy in Anderson, working as an electrical engineer. He finished his career at Plant 18, and he retired in 1993. Bill loved to spend time traveling, boating, water-skiing, camping, and playing and watching sports. He was an avid golfer and played frequently at Killbuck during the GM years. In his later years, he liked to travel and enjoy ballroom dancing. Bill is survived by his children, Kent (Thunhi) Duncan, of Fullerton, CA, and a granddaughter, Madison; and Mike Duncan, of Boca Raton, FL, and grandchildren, Katie, Ian, and Addison who reside with their mother Cindy in Perry, OH. He was preceded in death by his parents, Virginia R. Crandall and Bill "Doc" Crandall, of Anderson, and his first wife, Nancy. 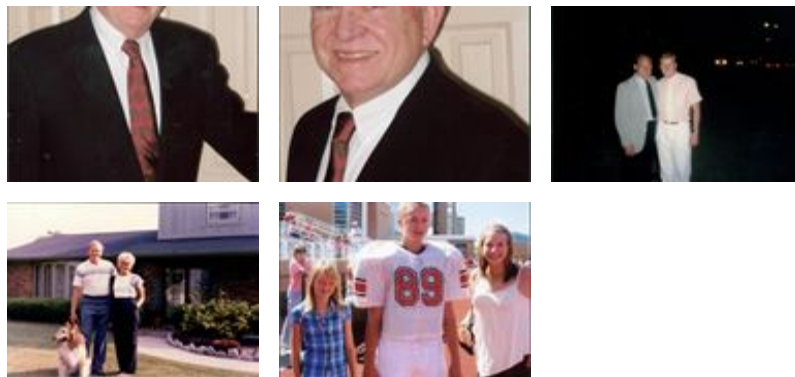
