Panama City, FL -William "Bill" Lawrence Steinbrunner, 75, of Anderson, passed away unexpectedly on October 11, 2012 at the Bay Medical Center, Panama City, FL. He was born on January 2, 1937 in Dayton, Ohio and resided most of his life in Anderson. He was a graduate of Hartford City High School in 1955 and University of Notre Dame in 1959.
