Wilson Cassel Shook, 94, of Pendleton, Indiana passed away on April 12, 2026. He was born on February 12, 1932 in Lawrenceburg, Tennessee and grew up in Lauderdale County, Alabama. He moved north for work, eventually settling in at Delco-Remy where he met and married Gay Pitman. They raised their family in rural Markleville.

Cass was a Utility Man for Delco-Remy Division of General Motors, retiring after 30 years of service.
